The Service Fee

Barley Burrow charges a service Fee for Funding Claimers

A £8 session for 3&4 year olds claiming the universal funding and the 30 hours/ 15 hours for working families funding

A £6 session for 18 month – 3 years claiming the Funded hours for working families

A £5 session for 2-year-olds who are receiving the Better 2 gether funding for Disadvantaged 2 year olds

The service Fee is calculated on a termly basis and divided into equal monthly payments to match the months within a term (Increase to £6 per session From April 2025)

(This is reviewed annually with inflation).

The Funds the setting receives from the government sadly only covers us for the 'Childcare' of your children and nothing else, all extra costs must be accounted for.

This service charge covers the costings for the extras that Barley Burrow creative childcare and early years learning Provides. This Fee is Compulsory for a space and un- changeable to cater individual requests as it enables us to give and provide the type and standard of Early years learning we deem essential for children to truly thrive, and become confident, Kind and clever and for the overall full package service we provide.

How you can use Funding At Barley Burrow

The Service fee gives blanket overall coverage for:

- Additional Resources for additional fun topics and activities which are not vital to the learning under the EYFS but allow us to explore fun additional and enhancements of.
- Consumables – Drinking Water, Milk, Snacks
(Breaky and Lunches additional costs apply)
- Usables – such as wipes, loo roll, hand soap, face and hand cloths, paper towles, Suncream, Sun hats, Aprons etc
- The 'Blossom Educational' interactive app which parent and team have access to which allows the team to send daily photo updates and observations, provides a messenger chat section for parents and Team members to communicate with each other during setting open hours, keyworkers of children to send seasonal reports on child's progress and for parents to keep up to date with the 'news and upcoming events' in setting, invoices are to sent via blossom educational app
- Outings (safety equipment, Bus fees, the Lower Adult to child ratio to accommodate this and insurance costs for this to take place- which become more common in Carrot crew and reflected in the increased cost)
- Additional learning sessions provided by special visitors in setting sessions and its open hours e.g Dave Hickory fun with maths sessions the dancing lady all factored into our curriculum in setting. (which become more common in Carrot crew and reflected in the increased cost)

For Special Activity days arranged outside of Open hours such as workshops/ Party's additional fees/ soft play entry etc costs will still apply.
